

Online User Group Meeting Minutes April 13, 2004

Steve Brown from Douglas County, CO, chairman of the user group, opened the online meeting with a welcome to all attendees.

The first topic of business was instituting annual membership dues. After some discussion, Kathy Fewins, of Pierce County, motioned for a \$150.00 annual fee, which was seconded by Nancy Roldan of CCI. The board will propose a list of appropriate expenses, which will be tracked in a manner to be determined. Nancy Roldan of CCI volunteered to act as Treasurer and distribute separate invoices to each county and collect the fees. The expenses will be reviewed annually. The current potential revenue collected would be \$2,400.00 for 16 RealWare counties.

The by-laws will be changed to reflect the institution of the membership dues. The Board will meet and propose changes to the by-laws, which will be communicated to each County and voted on.

The 2004 Annual User Group Conference will be held in Estes Park, Colorado again this year. From the unanimous response on the 2003 conference surveys, Estes Park was selected as the location this year. The dates reserved are Monday, November 8 through Wednesday, November 10, 2004. Due to the raise in Lake Shore Lodge's deposit policy, CCI was only able to block 10 rooms instead of the 25 from last year. It is recommended that counties make reservations at Lake Shore Lodge as soon as possible. The phone number to call is (800) 332-6867. Additional information will be forthcoming.

The group also discussed improved communication between CCI and the counties as well as from county to county.

- Enhancements – the group would like to have the ability to see a list of enhancements that are pending. CCI will create a list that will be put in the Knowledge Base in Parature. Users can then either view the article as desired, or subscribe to the article and receive notifications when the article has changed.
- Knows Issues – the group would also like the ability to see what know bugs/fixes are pending in RealWare. This would allow each county to see what other counties have already reported. A Known Issues list is currently in Parature, and will be copied to www.cciusergroup.org.
- Parature Coffee Club – it was suggested that CCI include a demonstration of Parature in an upcoming Coffee Club.

Kathy Fewins of Pierce County gave a brief description of their experiences in 4.04, which is currently on Pierce County's test box. 4.04 provided many fixes along with the ability to perform multiplicative models and multiple photos and sketches on the field inspection sheets.

Ron Dawes of Pierce County gave an excellent presentation of a multiplicative condominium model through a Power Point presentation. Bob Gloudemans was also present to answer questions and offer additional points to the modeling process that Pierce went through.
